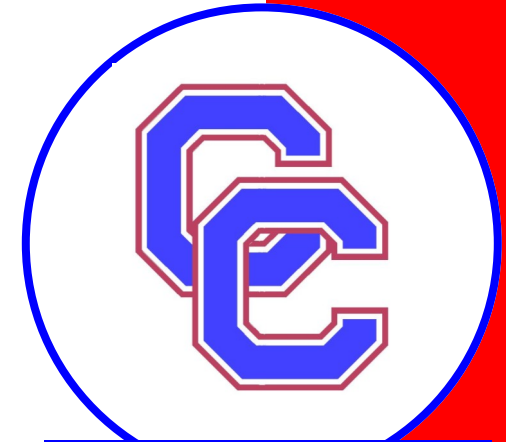

Finally the player will learn how to integrate individual strengths into team play.
